WHEREAS, residents of the State of Wisconsin are commemorating the very first Milwaukee County Winter Farmers' Market at the Tommy G. Thompson Youth Center at State Fair Park; and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Winter Farmers' Market begins November 7, 2009 and runs through April 24, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Winter Farmers' Market will provide Wisconsin residents access to fresh, locally grown, sustainable, healthy farm products; and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Winter Farmers' Market will offer the opportunity to Wisconsin farmers to sell their produce after the summer market season ends, therefore aiding the state's economy; and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Winter Farmers' Market is open to the public and merchants accept EBT payments, making fresh, healthy foods available to even those of limited financial resources; and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Winter Farmers' Market is being made possible in part by a grant from the USDA and sponsorship by the Wisconsin Apple Growers Association;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jim Doyle, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim NOVEMBER 7, 2009
